ROMSEY ABBEY AND MOTTISFONT HOUSE & GARDENS

8.45 a.m. Meet in the Old Deer Park Car Park TW9 2RA for a prompt start to Romsey where we will visit the White Horse Hotel for coffee (not included) before a tour of Romsey Abbey - please meet at the main North door. After lunch we will go to Mottisfont (10 minutes away) for a 40-minute guided tour of the house. We will leave for home at about 5pm.

Romsey Abbey in Hampshire is one of the most imposing churches in Southern England. It includes many treasures including two Saxon roods, a 16th-century reredos and the tomb of Lord Mountbatten.

Mottisfont Abbey, originally founded as an Augustinian priory in 1201, was converted into a house by Lord Chamberlain Sandys at the Dissolution and further altered in the 18th century. In 1939 Rex Whistler completed the trompe l'oeil in the drawing room. The extensive gardens include a beautiful walled garden with a famous collection of historic roses. Mottisfont is a National Trust property so members are admitted free. **Please bring your National Trust membership cards. Non-members will need to pay an additional £13.70 on the day.**
